



Background:

The campaign on sanitary towels arose out of a need, which was identified out of


The realization that a girl who remains at home for 4 days each month loses a total of 39 learning days and lowers her self-esteem, militates against girls' retention and transition was a key resolution to run the campaign.





Facts/Statistics:

A girl absent from school due to menses for 4 days in 28 days (a month) loses 13 learning days equivalent to 2 weeks of learning in every school term.



*For the Purpose of this presentation, the Girl is the FACT; the days she loses are the STATISTICS





Costs of Campaign:	
1-year the Girl needs 12 packets	216** Kshs.
	150*** IZaloa
3 under wears per Girl	150*** Kshs.
TOTALS	<u>366 Kshs.</u>

Further Considerations:

Statistics from the Ministry of Education shows that Kenya schools have over 1,039,000 menstruating girls from primary grade 6 to grade 8 and from secondary form one to secondary 4.

Out of the total number of girls, GCN estimates that about two fifths of the girls are from "able families" and are able to access sanitary protection. GCN plans to provide for the other category of the three fifths, which is about 600,000 girls from rural poor families and those from the slums of major towns and cities.
